On 19th Aug. ECO, Club members observed Van Mahotsava and conveyed the message

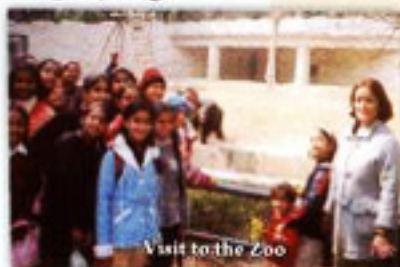
to keep their vicinity neat, clean and pollution free.

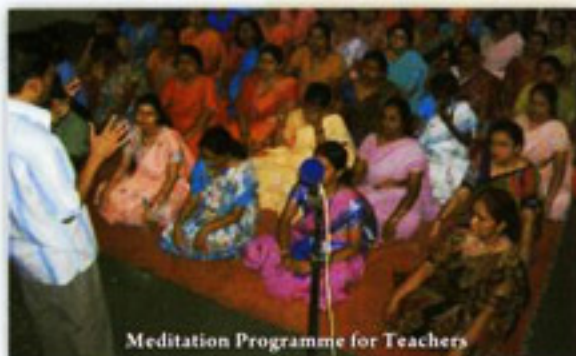

• Science Olympiad was organized by Education Heal Foundation on 12th Sep. '07 in which 17 students received

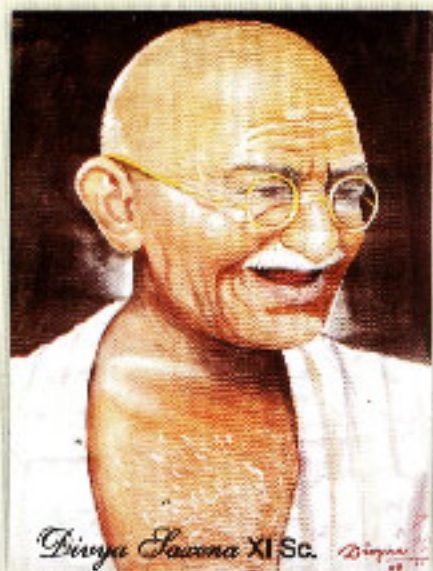


certificates of merit and Divya Saxena of class XI Sc. bagged the first position in the class, IIIrd position in the state and IXth position in the country.
